Wow where has this year gone? Sturgis is already behind us and hopefully some heat relief ... but it won't be long and we'll be donning leathers again ... Time flies. Well I hope you have had a chance to thank the senators that supported us ... I know not everyone is completely happy with the new law as it stands and I wanted to point out what ABATE's Board of directors have agreed we will strive for ... we need one voice in this going forward ... ok so ideally the amendments we want to see

21 and over with no tickets for 5 years to be grandfathered in without taking a BRC course.

Second passengers grandfathered to the rider ie if the rider qualifies so will the passenger ....

Now do I think we can get all that  $\dots$  maybe, but here's what I think we can get  $\dots$ 

21 and over with a M endorsement currently take only the online portion of the BRC (cost is 20\$ and can be taken at any time)

Second, passenger also only take the online course print certificate and qualify as a safety course ...

This is what we hope to get this next session and improve the law ... we got past the major hurdle and some will already be able to ride under the new law ... but I believe this would make more sense for passengers (if they never plan to drive a bike) and for the rest of us that have years of experience not to take courses away from new riders ... I do believe taking the course is not a bad thing personally and would encourage anyone to take it ... I did (another article this edition) and I was impressed. Anyway this is what we will work toward I encourage you to talk to your senators about it ... and come January hopefully we will tweak the law ... but do not change the narrative we have to be together on what we say or we'll end up with a mess of different ideas and confuse the issue. Be United!



#### Will you ask your Senators to protect the internal combustion engine?

Members of Congress are in the middle of a 6-week break away from Washington, D.C. While lawmakers won't return until after Labor Day, their staff are still working on several policy issues.

Earlier this year, the Biden Administration rolled out plans to shift this country to a majority electric vehicle market over the next ten years. In June, Senator Markwayne Mullin of Oklahoma introduced S.2090, the "Preserving Choice in Vehicle Purchases Act." The bill would amend the Clean Air Act to prevent a ban on the sale of internal combustion engines, effectively trumping any state law that outlaws their sale. S. 2090 is the Senate's version of H.R. 1435, which recently passed out of the House Energy and Commerce Committee.

While the House version of the bill is moving, the Senate version of the bill still needs more cosponsors. Will you ask your two Senators to protect the internal combustion engine?







## News from MRF!

#### You gotta fight for your right to repair - SUPPORT H.R. 906!

Do you enjoy working on your motorcycle? Do you want to guarantee access to the parts, tools and service information needed to modify, service and maintain your bike? If you answered yes to these questions, it's time to contact your member of the House of Representatives and ask them to cosponsor H.R. 906, the "Right to Equitable and Professional Auto Industry Repair Act" or the "REPAIR Act".



The REPAIR Act ensures that vehicle owners or repair shops are not denied access to the information, software or tools needed to work on vehicles. The proposed law also establishes rules regarding vehicle data access. This commonsense law will help preserve consumer choice and a fair marketplace.

As of July 1st, 32 members of the House of Representatives have signed on in support. That is twice as many as were on the bill before the Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF) held its Bikers Insider the Beltway event in May! The MRF is making a difference, let's keep up the pressure!

Congress returns to Washington D.C. Tuesday, after a two-week break. That makes it the perfect time to contact your lawmaker and tell them you support H.R. 906.



# RIGHT TO RIDE

**SHARE THE ROAD** is a motorcycle awareness program that promotes driver awareness and increases understanding of how motorcycles behave in traffic. ABATE of Nebraska, Inc. provides trained volunteers to present this program to the public. We believe that education and training are the best ways to prevent, and thereby reduce, motorcycle/automobile accidents.

Research shows that three fourths of crashes involving a motorcycle also involves another motor vehicle, which is usually at fault. Considering crash statistics and the increasing number of motorcyclists, the key to a safer riding mix is learning to SHARE THE ROAD.

Motorcycles are very different from automobiles - they are much smaller in size & are harder to see then automobiles. The failure of motorists to see motorcyclists in traffic is the most common cause of crashes. Car drivers who are involved in an accident with a motorcycle often do not see the motorcycle prior to the accident, or until it is too late to avoid having the accident.

The greatest risk area for a conflict between a motorcycle and a automobile is at an intersection...whether it is in the middle of an urban area, a driveway on a residential street, or anywhere where traffic may cross your path

of travel. Over one half of motorcycle/car accidents are caused by drivers entering a rider's right-of-way. Cars that turn left in from of motorcyclists, including cars turning left from the lane to the right, and cars on side streets that pull into the motorcyclists lane are the biggest dangers.

The fact remains.....the best way to prevent any accident is through Education, Safety, and Motorcycle Awareness Programs like SHARE THE ROAD.


